THE HLOAI FAMILY FINALLY FIND CLOSURE

The remains of two siblings, Masentle and Katlego Hloai aged 8 and 4 who were found at the open space in Grootvlei will finally be laid to rest at a funeral organised by the Department of Social Development. The two Hloai children were last seen playing in the neighborhood in Ipopeng. Two years after their disappearance skeletons of two children were found by the police in a shallow grave near Grootvlei Prison and were taken to forensic investigation for DNA test. The results which came out on the 16th of August confirmed that they were of the late Masentle and Katlego.

The clothes that they were last seen wearing also assisted the police to identify their bodies and up to now no suspects and arrest has been made so far, however investigations are still underway.

The funeral which will be attended by MEC Ntombela accompanied by members of the Free State Executive Council will be arranged as follows:
