CHANGES TO ADJUSTED ALERT LEVEL 1 COVID-19 REGULATIONS

- Based on the low infection and high recovery rate in the country, the government has made changes to Adjusted Alert Level 1 COVID-19 regulations.
- Those who test positive with no symptoms do not have to isolate.
- If you test positive with symptoms, the isolation period is 7 days.
- Contacts do not have to isolate unless they develop symptoms.
- Primary, secondary and special schools will return to daily attendance, and the social distancing of 1 meter for learners, no longer applies.
- The full revised regulations will be published on government websites.
- Government commends all South Africans who continue to observe COVID-19 regulations and protocols.
- The adjustments do not mean that we should let our guard down, COVID-19 is real and continues to claim lives.
- Let us continue to vaccinate, wear a mask, wash hands often or use an alcohol-based hand sanitiser, meet outside or in well ventilated spaces.
